4 Reasons Why The Bible Is True

OBJECTION: The Bible is not true.

ANSWER: On the subjects in which the Bible speaks, it is verifiably true.

The Bible is true because...

1. it can be verified historically. (Luke 1:1)
2. it was written accurately. (Luke 1:2a)
3. it was transmitted precisely. (Luke 1:2b)
4. it is useful personally. (Luke 1:3-4)
