Sermon Notes: Acts 17:22-34 Needing God

OBJECTION: I don't need God.

ANSWER: Everyone needs God, whether they admit it or not.

We need God to...

1. <u>clarify</u> our <u>worship</u>. (Acts 17:22-23)

2. give meaning to our existence. (Acts 17:24-28)

3. <u>rescue</u> us from <u>ourselves</u>. (Acts 17:29-34)

- 1. Paul observes in vv. 22-23 that the people of Athens were very religious. How have you observed people being "religious" that may or may not involve formal religion?

- 4. After moving from being religious (vv. 22-23) to explaining about the nature and purpose of God (vv. 24-28), what does Paul do next in vv. 29-31?
- 5. What were the three responses to Paul's message in vv. 32-34? Why did each person react this way?

6. How can you use this passage for those around you to see their need for God?
