Sermon Notes: Luke 5:17-26 Our Greatest Need

**MAIN POINT:** Only Jesus has the authority to forgive our sins.

Jesus' authority to forgive sins is...

1. <u>needed</u> by <u>all</u>. (Luke 5:17-20)

2. <u>rejected</u> by <u>some</u>. (Luke 5:21)

3. <u>received</u> by the <u>repentant</u>. (Luke 5:22-26)
