Sermon Notes: Luke 6:1-11 Jesus' Moral Standard

MAIN POINT: Jesus' moral standard is far better than our moral standard.

Jesus' moral standard frees us from...

1. <u>rigid rules</u> so we can <u>meet needs</u>. (Luke 6:1-5)

2. <u>criticizing others</u> so we can <u>care for others</u>. (Luke 6:6-11)
