

Sermon Notes: Job 1:1-2:13
Enduring Suffering

MAIN POINT: We endure suffering by acknowledging God's sovereignty.

1. **We endure suffering by acknowledging God's sovereignty over Satan.** (Job 1:6-12)
2. **We endure suffering by acknowledging God's sovereignty over our possessions.** (Job 1:13-22)
3. **We endure suffering by acknowledging God's sovereignty over our health.** (Job 2:1-10)
